### Feast Days This Week

Mon. June 11 – St. Barnabas, apostle

Wed. June 13 – **St. Anthony of Padua**, priest, doctor of the Church

**Ordinary Time** – During ordinary time, the Church celebrates the fullness of the mystery of the Lord Jesus. The people of God praise Him by celebrating the paschal mystery of the death and resurrection of Jesus. On the first day of the week, the Lord's Day, God assembles His beloved people to hear His word, to reflect upon it, to offer a living sacrifice of praise, to eat and drink the banquet of the Lord. Then God sends them forth to proclaim this love by their words and actions. Sunday is the original Christian feast day, following the tradition handed down from the apostles' time, for this was the day of the Lord's resurrection. Today's Christian communities continue this tradition by celebrating every Sunday as the day of the Risen Lord.

**Wedding** – Next Saturday, June 16, we will be celebrating the wedding of Domenic Pellegrino and Alexandria Piccirilli. We offer them our best wishes and ask God to bless them and grant them happiness, peace, and joy and strength in trials, all the days of their lives together.

**Your Personal Consecration** – Now that the family has consecrated itself to the Sacred Heart, each member should cultivate the habit of consecrating, daily all his activity to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This can be done by using any formula, but the formula proposed by the Apostolate of Prayer (The Morning Offering or the Daily Offering) offers these advantages: 1) It unites us with Jesus in all the Masses being offered throughout the world. 2) It is inspired by God's love for people revealed in His pierced heart. 3) It invokes the intercession of Mary. 4) It shows loyal concern for the Church and her apostolic goals. 5) It puts into practice the spirit of prayer.

### Living the Gospel by helping youth rebuild their lives

Sarah couldn't get along with her mother, so she tried living on the streets at age 14. She hitchhiked to Toronto to move in with her cousin, who soon kicked her out. Having no place to go, Sarah decided to try Sancta Maria House. She initially hated the structure and rules. However, the supportive staff won her trust and helped her return to school. At the end of her stay, she restored her relationship with her mother.

### Sixteenth Anniversary of the Founding of St. Padre Pio Parish

– Next weekend is the 16<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Founding of our Parish. On June 16, 2002, St. Padre Pio was canonized as a saint of the Church. On the same day, the Parish of St. Padre Pio was established. A two-day celebration marked both events. Since then, June 16<sup>th</sup> was celebrated every year as the Founding of the Parish. However, when a new church is solemnly dedicated, the date of the church is celebrated, which is also the feast day of St. Padre Pio, Sept. 23.

**Children's Liturgy** program concludes this weekend. We would like to thank all the dedicated parishioners who volunteered their time to teach our children, and a special thanks to the coordinators of the program. The Children's Liturgy Program will resume in the Fall.

**Mary Grove Camp Collection** – will be taken up at all Masses. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul helps over 1,000 girls each summer attend camp. Each camper's holiday is fully subsidized through the generous support of an annual collection held through the Archdiocese. Envelopes may be picked up on the counter in the Narthex.

**Handicapped Parking** – Near the side entrance to the church, on the left side, there are 4 parking spots, two of which are handicapped parking. Some people come early for church and immediately take the two handicapped parking spots, to which they are entitled, leaving the other two regular spots empty. If they were to take the two regular spots instead (it's only a difference of a few feet), this would allow two more cars with handicapped parking stickers to park close to the side entrance. This would be a great courtesy, thus allowing four cars with handicapped stickers, instead of only two, to park near the entrance.

**Spiritual Chain Letters or Novenas** – Spiritual chain-letters, which tell you to send a certain amount of letters to other people in order for your request to be granted, or Novenas, which tell you to leave a certain amount of copies in a church in order for your request to be granted are FORBIDDEN by the Church. Some years ago, the Archdiocese put out a letter regarding these things, saying that they are not allowed. The only Novenas that are accepted by the Church, are those in pamphlet form, usually with an Imprimatur by a Bishop. If we expect to receive an answer to our requests, we need to obey the Church and use the prayers allowed by the Church.
