Parents of children who are going to receive these sacraments must present your child as a candidate to the Parish at any of the Masses on the weekend of Nov. 3/4. You will need an Enrolment Form in order to do this. Every part of the form must be completed. You will need to Photostat a copy of your child's baptism certificate in a Roman Catholic Church (not an original). If you have any questions about this, you should call the Parish Office at 905-893-7879 for clarification. The copy of the baptismal certificate should be stapled to the back of the Enrolment Form. If you did not receive an Enrolment Form at the Parents' Meeting it may be picked up after Mass until the weekend of Oct. 27/28. It will not be available the weekend of Nov. 3/4, the dates of the special Enrolment Ceremony to be held at all the Masses. The Enrolment Form with the copy of the baptismal certificate will be presented by you and your child. **ONLY CHILDREN WHO ARE ENROLED AT THIS CEREMONY MAY RECEIVE FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION.**

Your son or daughter must present themselves as a candidate to the Parish at any of the Masses on the weekend of Nov. 10/11. They will need an Enrolment Form in order to do this. Every part of the form must be completed. You will need to Photostat a copy of your child's baptism in a Roman Catholic Church (not an original).
